

**MONGOLIAN BARBECUE IN LONDON'S COVENT GARDEN TO
ENTREPRENEUR PAUL CORRETT**

The founders of the Mongolian Barbeque chain have sold their last remaining UK site in London's Covent Garden to restaurant and bar operator Corrett Restaurants.

The 3,800sq ft unit on Maiden Lane was acquired by Paul Corrett, who also owns the Big Easy in Fulham and Maggiore in Covent Garden, for a positive premium with annual rent of £225,000.

Corrett plans to turn the venue into a second Big Easy as part of a rollout of the US-style restaurant and sports and music bar brand.

Matt Kirby and John Dodds, the owners of the Mongolian Barbeque brand that reached around 15 sites in the UK, currently have outlets in Dublin, Istanbul and Malta, as well as concessions in Excel London.

Property company Selsian handled the deal.
